### **Criteria for the selection of the Pharmacist of the Year**

1. Must currently be a registered pharmacist
2. Nominee must be a paid up member of the PSJ
3. The level of participation in PSJ activities by nominee must be good, very good, or excellent
4. The total amount of CE seminars attended by nominee (> 6 seminars)
5. The total amount of credits obtained by the nominee (> 12 credits)
6. Members will visit the work place of the nominees. They will utilise a set criteria designed to identify pharmacists that exhibit good relationship with their patients and staff, who counsel their patients adequately and who have practised within the guidelines as stipulated by the Pharmacy Council of Jamaica.
7. The level of participation in community activities must be notable.
8. An interview of the nominee will be conducted by a select panel
9. Nominator must be a paid up member of the PSJ
